

At a legal town meeting held at Sardsbury on the sixth day of November 1883. the articles in the Warrant for said meeting were taken up and acted upon as follows.

- Art 1 Chose James Moore Moderator
- Art 2 Voted to refund the amount of a poll tax paid by John E. Dwyer for the year 1882
- Art. 3 No reports presented
- Art 4 Voted to authorize the Overseers of the poor to purchase one or two horses for use at the poor farm, as they may think for the interest of the town, that in case two new horses are purchased, both the old horses be disposed of, and that the price to be paid for two horses shall not exceed four hundred dollars
- Art. 5. Voted to pass over this article by a vote of thirty-nine in the affirmative to thirty in the negative
- Art. 6 Voted that the subject referred to in this article be left in the hands of the Selectmen for settlement

Then voted to dissolve this meeting.
