To Joanna L. Willis Constable of
the Town of Sudbury in Said County: Greeting;

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts
you are required to notify and warn the inhabitants
of the Town of Sudbury qualified to vote in elections
and Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall in said
Sudbury, on Monday the third day of March next,
at ten o'clock in the forenoon then and there
to act on the following Articles. Viz:

Art. 1. To choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting

Art. 2 To choose all necessary Town Officers for the year ensuing.

Art. 3. To determine the manner of Repairing Highways
and Bridges the ensuing year and grant money
for the same, to do or act on the subject as the
Town may think best

Art. 4. To hear and act on reports

Art. 5. To see if the Town will take any measures to procure
gravel for the repair of roads in said Town, to do
or act as the town may think best.

Art. 6. To see what action the town will take in regard
to a claim of Lyman Parmenter for damage
in discontinuing the road leading to the "David
Howe Place", to do or act &c

Art. 7 To see if the Town will close its fiscal year at
such time as to enable the reports to be printed
for distribution before March Meeting, to do
or act &c

Art. 8 To see if the Town will elect the Overseers of the
Poor for one, two and three years, or take advan-
tage of the act relative thereto.
