

- Art 9 To see if the Town will cause the school-house lot in District No. 5. to be graded and fenced to do or act on said subject as the town may judge best.
- Art. 10. To see if the town will authorize the Collector to collect any unpaid taxes, to do or act as the town may think best.
- Art. 11 To see if the Town will take any action relative to their Hooks & Ladders, to do or act,
- Art. 12. To see if the town will make any alterations in the By-laws of the Goodnow Library, to do or act on said subject as the town may think best.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting up attested copies thereof at the Town House, at each public Meeting-house, at each Post Office, and at each Railroad Station in said town two Sabbaths, at least before the time for holding said Meeting.

Whereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk, at the time and place of Meeting as aforesaid.
