- Art. 4. To hear and act on reports
- Art. 5. To grant money for all necessary Town purposes
- Art. 6. To determine for what purposes and under what con-
ditions the Town Hall may be used the ensuing year.
To act on said subject as the Town think best.
- Art. 7. To see what action the Town will take to supply the several
Schools in town with fuel the ensuing year. To act on said
subject as the Town think best
- Art. 8. To see if the town will grant money to suitably mark
soldiers' graves and for observing Decoration day
- Art. 9. Shall Licenses be granted for the sale of intoxicating
liquors ⁱⁿ this town for the ensuing year
- Art. 10. To determine the manner of collecting Taxes the
for the ensuing year and provide for the collecting
of the same
- Art. 11. To see if the town will authorize their Treasurer to borrow
such sums of money as may be necessary for the Town's use,
and in anticipation of this year's Taxes
