

- Art. 12. To see if the Town will cause any of their school houses to be painted the present year and grant money for the same.
- Art. 13. To provide for the distribution of the income of the Town Funds.
- Art. 14. To see if the Town will grant the sum of \$200 to gravel the road from the house of Luther Butterfield to Framingham line.
- Art. 15. To see if the Town will grant the sum of \$100 for special repairs on the road from the house of H. H. Brown to Framingham line.
- Art. 16. To see if the Town will rescind the vote passed at a former meeting, under which an Auditor was chosen and discharge said Auditor from further service.
- Art. 17. To see if the Town will enlarge the Town Officers' room, and make any additional provision for the safe keeping of the Town Books of Record.
- Art. 18. To see if the Town will make any repairs in the Ante-Rooms of the Town Hall.
- Art. 19. To see if the town will grant the free use of the Town Hall for the Hudson Lectures, Farmers Clubs, and meetings, to do or act.
- Art. 20. To see if the town will build a Lockup, to do or act.
- Art. 21. To see if the Town will rent Armory Hall, to do or act.
- Art. 22. To see if the Town will make any repairs on the road leading past the house of Thomas E. Bent to land of Albert Heynes, and establish bounds on said road.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies thereof, at the Town House at each of the Public Meeting houses, at each Post Office and at each Railroad Station in said Town, Two Sabbaths at least before the time for holding said meeting.

Whereof fail not and make due return of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the Town Clerk at or before the time of holding said meeting.
