At a legal meeting of the inhabitants of Sndbury  
held April 7<sup>th</sup> 1884 The Articles in the foregoing War-  
rant, were taken up and acted upon as follows. Viz:

Art 1 Chose James Moore Esq Moderator

Art. 2 Voted that the Selectmen and Dr George A Oviatt Jr  
constitute the "Board of Health", and Dr Oviatt was  
chosen to said Office by ballot.

Herbert S. Jones was chosen Treasurer and  
collector of Taxes for the ensuing year.

Art. 3 List of jurors was reported by the Selectmen, revised  
and accepted by the town

Art 4 The Annual report on Unideposts and boards was read  
and accepted, and the matter of new posts and boards  
referred to the Selectmen

Report (Annual) of Overseers of the poor; trustees of the  
Woodrow Library read and accepted; also report of  
School Committee on painting School House No. 3.

The School Committee also made a verbal report  
concerning grading and fencing School House lot  
No. 5, and repairing fences on lots No. 1, and No. 3,  
and the town voted to grant the sum of \$150. to be  
used for the purposes above-named, under the di-  
rection of the School Committee

A verbal report was made by the Committee chosen  
at March meeting last to investigate the "Lyman  
Parmenter road case", together with a proposition  
for the settlement of said case by the counsel for  
said Parmenter, and the town voted that said  
Committee be instructed to consult with all  
the land owners on the discontinued road, and
