

- Art 10. duties of said offices be fixed at the sum of fifty dollars for the ensuing year.
- Art. 11. Voted to authorize the Town Treasurer to borrow money as proposed in this article
- Art. 12. Voted to pass over this Article
- Art. 13. Voted that the Assessors be directed to distribute the interest arising from the funds left for the "silent fund"
- Art. 14. Voted to grant \$200. for the purpose named the expenditure of the same to be placed in the hands of the Selectmen, to be let out by contract to the lowest bidder
- Art 15 Voted to grant \$100. for the purpose named, to be expended as provided for in article 14. of this warrant
- Art. 16. Passed over
- Art. 17. Voted that the subjects named in this article be placed in the hands of the Selectmen, and the sum of \$500. was granted to defray expenses of the proposed work.
- Art. 18. Voted to leave this matter with the Selectmen
- Art. 19. Voted to grant the free use of the town hall for the purposes proposed in this Article
- Art. 20. Voted to instruct the Selectmen to provide two cells in the Town House for the purpose named in this article.
- Art. 21. Voted to leave this matter with the Selectmen with authority to act as they think proper
- Art 22 Voted to instruct the Selectmen to establish the boundary on the road near the house of Thomas E. Bent
