In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts,
you are required to notify the inhabitants of the town
of Sudbury, qualified to vote in elections, to meet
at the town Hall in said town on Tuesday the
4th day of November, next, it being the Tuesday
next after the first Monday of said month, to
bring in to the Registrars of Voters, their votes
for Presidential Electors, a Representatives in
Congress for the Ninth district; For Governor
Lieutenant Governor, Secretary, Treasurer and
Receiver-General, Auditor, and Attorney-General of
the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Councillor
for District number six, Senator for Middlesex
District Number Five, Representative in General
Court for Middlesex District number Twenty-
seven, and one County Commissioner for the
County of Middlesex; allow one ballot.

The Polls will open at ten o'clock A.M. and
may be closed at two o'clock P.M.

And you are also required to notify the in-
habitants of said town of Sudbury, qualified to
vote in Town affairs, to meet at the Town Hall
in said town on Tuesday the fourth day of Nov-
ember next at one o'clock in the afternoon
then and there to act on the following articles,
viz:

Art 1 To choose a Moderator to preside in said Meeting

Art 2 To hear and act on reports

Art 3 To see what action the town will take
to provide fuel for the several Schools the
ensuing year

Art 4 To see what instructions the town will give
the Overseers of Poor in regard to the Widow Dora
Smith and family to do or act as the town
think best.
