

Art. 5. To see if the Town desires to accept of a donation of ten thousand dollars offered by George Goodnow of Boston, to his native town of Sudbury, for the purpose of establishing a fund, the income of which he desires to be used by the Select men of said town for the time being, to assist such citizens of the town, who are not at the time of receiving the assistance, paupers, but who may for any cause, be in need of temporary or private assistance.

Art 6 To see if the Town will make their annual March meeting come on the third Monday of the month.

And you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting attested copies thereof at the Town House, at each of the public Meeting Houses, at each Post Office, and at each Railroad Station in said town, two Sabbaths at least before the time of said meeting.

Yeereof fail not and make return of this Warrant, with your doings thereon to ourselves at the meeting aforesaid.
