November 18 select men sent a hoifer of said twadways to benj parvins  
for one pound fifteen shillings to be pay either in money or other ways ad  
maist best unto good of twadway want whing shew somed not satisfied with  
all the sam tim Zarriah maynard tok said twadways man to keep and winter  
for her work with this proviso that if any person did apper that wold  
Buy her he wold let her Go
