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Wherefore it is concluded by the town that all
the lands not every parcel thereof has been divided and bounded
shall be for a year or more for ever
of the house of Robert David into the common part being given to the
gracious meadows & for upon a string of land to water the same
not land for granted for a year or more shall not be divided or laid
down without the consent of the mayor and inhabitants of the town
and the said two towns that is between the said mill brook
and the said west side of the town and the said water
and bounded on the south side by the opportunity of our line
rounding water house and the said water except all the land
as said be granted out in particular that is to say a part of
the land lying between the mill brook & the said water
also a part of the land which the flat belonging to it lying between
the said water and an adjacent great river on the other side
also an other flat of land that lies westward from
the same and containing some 3 or 4 acres & granted out
into particular manner. Wherefore it is concluded that the
said towns are to be limited and fixed in the quantity
of the quantity of a acre the said inhabitants are stated in the
division of the meadows or shall be in stated in by the
said mayor and inhabitants provided that the said mayor and
inhabitants of the town shall be allowed to give a quantity of a acre
as shall be required. And
forasmuch more because that the said inhabitants have not so
full of cattle as to feed the same the said mayor and
inhabitants it is concluded permitted unto the said inhabitants to put on the
said cattle out for the said town and the said mayor and
inhabitants shall provide the said food at any time they shall think fit.

Wherefore it is concluded that what for ever the said meadows that is to say
the said meadows in the town and not yet divided or given
out to any person or persons that the said meadows shall
be kept on to be fed by the common of the town
the first day of the 3d month of the year
the said meadows shall be possessed of any such meadows that shall be
found in the town and the said mayor and inhabitants shall be
bound to sell the said food at any time they shall think fit
the said food shall be sold at the price of five pence.
