Whereas it is concluded by the town that all these land w^{ch}
every parcell thereof sh^{al} be described and bounded sh^{al} lye for a
com^{on} common for ever that is to say all the land southward that
lye from the south east corner of the house of Robert Daines
unto the common cart bridge going to Edmund Goodnows meadowe
and so upon a straight lye to waterlowne bounde w^{ch} lande sh^{al} be
granted for a com^{on} common sh^{al} never be reuoced or laid downe
wthout the consent of every inhabitant that hath right in comonage
All the land w^{ch} sh^{al} be contained wthin these termes
that is betweene the said house of Robert Daines and the cart
bridge before specified southward wthin the 4 mile bound first granted
downe to the great river and bounded on the side w^{ch} the extremity
of our lye descendyng waterlowne and fudbury all our land w^{ch} sh^{al} be
wthin these termes except all such land as hath beene granted out
in particular that is to say a necke of upland lyeinge betweene
mill brooke and pynd brooke also another necke of land w^{ch} sh^{al} be
the flate belonging to it lyeinge betweene the aforesaid necke
and the great river on the other side also another flate of
land that lye westward from the said containinge some 3 or 4
furlonges and granted out to particular men

The Inhabitants of the towne are to be limited and sized in the
pullinge in of rattle upon the said comon according to the
quantity of meadow the said inhabitants are rated in upon the
division of the meadow or sh^{al} be rated in by purcase for ever
provided they buy w^{ch} the meadow the liberty of comonage
allotted to such a quantity of acre as sh^{al} be purcased.
