

Orders agreed upon the 4th day of the third
month 1641

It is ordered that every hogg taken in any planted field
without a yeale the owner of every such hogg so found shall
pay for every default so made halfe a bushell of rorne besides
all the damages. the one halfe to him that takes the hogg the
other halfe to the towne.

It is ordered that every one that keeps any hoggs more than his
owne. within one fortnight after this day shall ride them out of
the towne. and for every hogg that shall be kept by any man
more than his owne. shall for every hogg that he doth keep
more than his owne for every week five shillings he shall pay

It is ordered that those men that are deputed to look to the
fowles shall have power to distrayne for every rod of fowle
not lawfull halfe a bushell of rorne. the one halfe to him
that looks to the fowles. the other halfe to the towne.

within the towne after the 22nd of this present month
shall forfeit for every cage so found twelve pence
Edmund Goodman is appointed to look to this behalf and
allowed for his service the one half of the forfeited
the other half to be accountable to the
men for it
