Allso ten acres of vylage lying upon pineylands.
Allso twenty five acres of vylage lying on the west side of
Kiln and lye on the south side of the moor of Bryan.
Also be the same moor at less lying to the land of
Gore.

Allso myne acres of meadow and a half be the said moor
less lying in the great river meadow between the moor
John Maynard and John here.

Allso three acres of half of meadow be the said moor
lying in the great river meadow between the meadow of
John and John here.

Allso the said John moore bought all towns right & per
belonging or in any wife appertaining to the said John
several parcells of land with all further division of land
be laid out according to that proportion of land before
mentioned.

Allso the said John moore bought of Henry this house
with the house moore & lying to it of the house of the
by estimation four acres or there about be the said moor
lying between the house of John Maynard and the house
late of Edmund this and now in the possession of the said
moor.

Allso one acre and a half of vylage between the land of
John Maynard & the land late of Edmund this now in the
possession of the said John moore and it parted from the
house by the highway.
