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It is agreed betwene the townsmen of the town of
and John Kutter on the other part that the said John
for his parte shall for same how & frame a house for a
house thirty foote longe twenty foote wide eight foote
high these foote between studds two cross dorments
five storey windowed two wth four light a poore
four wth three light a poore and to undertake betwene
the studds wth frame it to be made ready to raise the fo
works in May next

And the town for their parte doth covenant to draw all
timber to place and to helpe to raise the house beams
and also to pay to the said John Kutter for the said
five pound that is to say three pound to be paid
at three shillings a bushell or in money in and upon the
seaventy day of this present month and the other four
to be paid in money rent and rattle the same & rattle to
be paid by two men of the town and to be taken by the town
the other to be taken by John Kutter and to be paid at the house
that the frame shall be by the said John Kutter finished
