

Land formerly granted to Thomas Calbraud & now in the
possession of ~~Thomas~~ Sara Calbraud widow layd out at the
owne appointment of Bryan Wendleton and Edmond Goodnow
the 23rd of October 1643

The land lying about the millhouse containing by estimation forty
two acres of upland or there about be the same more or less
having a hedge way on every side of it & also all the parcels of
meadowe lying within the said land be the same more or less.

Also all one parcel of meadowe containing by estimation twelue acres
or there about be the same more or less lying on the south side
of the haypitte & burkilnes

Also eight acres of upland be the same more or less lying on the
east side of the foresaid meadowe and butte upon the ymo playnd
on the east side of it with all the rambery swamps adjoining to it
lying to the land of Robert Daniell also the part of meadowe lying
between the west side of the said land be the same more or less lying between the meadowe of
Bryan Wendleton & John Daniell

Also the said land of Bryan Wendleton containing one acre of meadowe be the
same more or less lying in the west meadowe adjoining to the north
side of the meadowe of ~~Robert Daniell~~ ^{Robert Daniell} & also the said land of Bryan Wendleton
containing & adjoining to the north east end of the meadowe of the said widow Daniell

Also the said land of Edmond Goodnow one acre of upland be the same more
or less lying in the south side of the lower bounde of Sudbury betwixt the
land of John Hayme on the south side of it & adjoining to a fence
running from the said lower bounde to the river on the north side of it

Also the said land of John Hayme one acre of upland
the land before expressed with the betwixt the land of the said John
Hayme about mentioned & the land of John Daniell.

John Hayme bought of Thomas Calbraud one acre and a halfe of upland be the
same more or less lying betwixt the land of the said John Hayme adjoining
to his now dwelling house & the land of John Daniell

Also the said land of Henry Colbar two acres of upland be the same more or less lying
betwixt the land formerly granted to Joseph Daniell & now in the
possession of William Daniell senior on the north side of it and a fence
running from the house of Whillemon whale to the river on the south side
of it

Also eight acres of upland be the same more or less lying in the south side
of the lower bounde the north end of it lying to the hedge way leading
from waterstone to Mr Dunstons farm the west side of it adjoining
to the land of John Daniell & adjoining to the land of John Colbar

Also the said land of John Colbar ten acres of upland be the same more or less
lying in the south part of the lower bounde & lying betwixt the hedge
way leading from waterstone to Mr Dunstons farm & adjoining to the
east side of the land of John Daniell.
