

Robert Darnell of Sudbury bought appointed to be true and lawful
unto Robert Darnell by virtue of a letter of Attorney bearing
date of June 1642 that said Darnell sold & alienated & confirmed
to Peter Noyes of Sudbury twenty acres of upland be the same more
less w^{ch} land was formerly granted to the said Robert Darnell
lyng upon Tymber necke, the west end buttynge to the River the east
to the river common & rynged to the south side of the land of the said
Peter Noyes

Thomas Dydell bought of Edmond Dyer five acres of upland be the same
more or less lyng in the south parte of the town bounde, the south
side lyng to the common & rynged to the land of the said Edmond Dyer
southward & northward to the higg way leading from Sudbury to
Dunstable Harrow,

Robert Darnell bought of Anthony White fifteen acres of upland
be the same more or less lyng in a north of land betwene
and ymber brooke & lyng betwene the land of Peter Noyes and
the land granted to Thomas Dyer five acres whereof the
Anthony bought of William Parker

Also ten acres of upland meadow be the same more or less
in the great river meadow, in two parcell thurth acres lyng
betwene the meadowe formerly granted to Thomas Dyer on
the one side & William Parker on the other the other parcell
lyng betwene the meadow of Peter Noyes on the one side & the
meadow granted to Henry Dyer on the other side w^{ch} all
& p^{ar}cellages belongynge to the said Anthony White in Sudbury,

Granted to Henry Dyer five acres of upland be the same more or less
lyng in the south parte of the town bounde buttynge upon the
side of the Dunstable Harrow & upon the common southward
& upon the north to the higg way leading from Sudbury to
Dunstable Harrow

Also granted to Henry Dyer ten acres of upland lyng upon
the p^{ar}cell playne parted from the meadow of Edmond Dyer
by a higg way & lyng north to a north called ground

Granted to Thomas Noyes ten acres of upland lyng on the
west side of the River be the same more or less rynged to the
south side of the land formerly granted to Thomas Noyes
a higg way on the south side w^{ch} parte the said land from
the land of Robert Darnell

Granted to John Dandford fifteen acres of upland lyng
on the west side of the River be the same more or less rynged
northward to a p^{ar}cell of land called Harrow Hill & southward to
the land of John Toll

Also seven acres of upland lyng on the west side of the River
& lyng betwene the land of Henry Dyer and Robert Darnell

Also a parcell of land being an acre & half or there about
lyng betwene the house lott of Bryan Dandford & the
higg way & rynged to the fresh pond
