

It is agreed between Edmond Tyre John Moore & John how that when Edmond Tyre had formerly granted to him six acres of land now to be sold of William Ward and John Moore had ten acres of upland lying in parrall to John how had eight acres on the west side of the river the parts had by a ioynt consent exchanged say with other that is to say from that day the said John Moore shall possess & enjoy the eight acres of upland formerly granted to John how and John how shall possess and enjoy the six acres formerly granted to Edmond Tyre And all the two acres of the aforesaid ten acres lying upon parrall to John how it be at the ioynt next to the land of Edmond Goodnow And the said Edmond Tyre shall possess and enjoy the other eight acres of land which he had upon parrall to the said Edmond Tyre formerly sold to the said John Moore witness Jo: onto Edmond Goodnow Hugh Griffyn

And the first It is agreed between Edmond Goodnow and John how that the said Edmond shall for ever enjoy all the meadow of the said John how lying upon the west side of the river being a part of the first addition of meadow granted to the said John how by the said parrall of meadow And between the meadows formerly granted to Edmond Goodnow on the one side and the meadow of Thomas Glyn on the other side in consideration in evidence of the said John how shall for ever enjoy one rod breadth of meadow upon the east side of the river of the said parrall of meadow the said Edmond bought of Thomas Glyn and lies between the meadows of John how and the meadows of John how.

And the eight Edmond Goodnow and William Lerley former land exchangers parrall of land being with other viz the said Edmond hath delivered unto the said William Lerley a parrall of upland containing by estimation five acres or there about lying on the west side of the river being the more or less six acres whereof the town gave to the said Edmond three acres more of the same parrall the said Edmond bought of John how and the same may be a part of the said Edmond third addition of upland and parrall of meadow and lying first acres or there about six acres of the said meadow or less lying on the east side of the river in the great meadow of the said Edmond first division of the said division of meadow and a part of a first division of meadow that was laid out for a minister of the said parrall of the said Edmond bought of the town.

And the satisfaction whereof the said William Lerley hath delivered unto the said Edmond Goodnow a parrall of upland containing by estimation five acres or there about being the parrall granted to Joseph Carter alias trader of upland lying upon parrall to the said parrall of upland formerly granted to Mr Gourdam and joined to the land of the said Edmond Goodnow Also a parrall of meadow containing by estimation five acres or there about of the same more or less lying in the great meadow of the said John how and of the meadow to the other being the second division of the meadow granted to Joseph Carter viz parrall of land granted to the said William Lerley and the trodded acres lying upon parrall to the said parrall granted to Mr Gourdam and Mr Gourdam sold to the said William Lerley.
