

December the 14th 21 it agreed between walter hayne of Sudbury
Thomas Kinge that the said walter hayne shall for ever possesse & en-
joye four acres of meadowes lying on the west side of the River in the great
River meadowes lying between the meadowes of the said walter hayne
and four acres of meadowes was first granted to George Munnings
& by him sold to Mr Peter Moxe & by him sold to the said Thomas
Kinge; And that the said Thomas Kinge shall for ever possesse &
enjoye a parcell of meadowe containing by estimation four acres or
thereabouts lying on the east side of the River lying between the
meadowes of Mr Walgrave and the River and a parcell of meadowes
was formerly granted to the said walter hayne as parts of the
first division of meadowes for witness whereof the parties
said good unto for their laude the day and year above written

with us, Lawd to

William ward of Sudbury bought of Mr William Helham a parcell
of meadowe containing by estimation eight acres or thereabouts
be the same more or lesse with all right in commonage thereto
belonging lying to ward Concord lying in the way that leads
from Sudbury to Concord joining to the land of the said William
ward and a parcell of meadowes is parts of the third division of
meadowes of the said Mr William Helham

with us good unto Hugh Griffen

Peter Moxe Gave unto John Freeman sixteene acres of meadowe
be the same more or lesse lying in the great River meadowes
being a parte of the second division of meadowes of the said
Peter Moxe and lies next to eight eight acres of meadowes
of the said John Freeman and eight acres joining to Concord
lying And the said Peter Moxe Gave unto the said John
Freeman all right in commonage belonging unto the said sixteen
acres of meadowes.

Also granted to John Freeman six acres of meadowe be the
same more or lesse lying in a piece of inland meadow next to
Concord lying lying between the meadowes of Mr William
Hillam & the meadowes of John Harwinter Junior and a parcell
of meadowe is the third division of meadowes of the said
John Freeman.
