Granted to Edmund first son and of ³ ~~manor~~
lying in the fourth part of the town bound northward
to the land of Thomas Aldoll eastward to the land of
John Went & westward towards the land granted to the said
Edmund first

All for twenty acres of upland lying in the fourth
part of the town bound westward to the land of the same
Dunham & northward towards the land of Henry first

All for thirty five acres of upland lying upon the
butteridge eastward upon the land of Robert Darrell & on
the west to the land of Edmund Goodenow.

All for nine acres of upland lying upon a piece of land
now to the south of the long side in the north east
of the town bound & lying between the land of Margaret
twadaway & the land of John the Duke

All for ten acres of meadow lying in the fourth
part of the town bound now to the land of Thomas Goodenow
& Robert Darrell

All for Edmund first bought of Margery Aldoll widow
for dwelling house with six acres of upland to the said
manor or less lying in the fourth part of the town bound
between the land of the same whole & the land of
the said Edmund first

Granted to Walter Haynes a piece of meadow containing
by estimation two acres & half or there about lying
on a piece of meadow which runs out of the pasture
fourth ward nor into the meadows of Henry the Duke

All for two acres more of meadows lying fourth ward
of the foresaid two acres & half in a piece by itself

All for one acre of meadows lying in a piece by itself
in the north side the foresaid two acres & half of meadows

All for eleven acres of meadows in the same meadows
lying between the meadows of Edmund Goodenow
on the west & a bed of ponds on the east.

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Granted to John Haynes four acres of upland on the west
side of the town lying fourthly to the highway & west
to the land of Thomas All for five acres of meadows
lying in the gulch between the meadows of John
Bladford & the same North All for one acre of meadows
lying northward from the same meadows now to the
meadows of John the Duke
