

Granted to Thomas Mylet the area of repleat lying on the west  
side of the river between the meadow of the said Thomas  
Mylet & the right way. Also seven acres & a quarter of  
meadow lying in a parcel of meadow that goes out of the  
Gulfe towards the river bounde & lies between the meadow  
of Robert Bault & the meadow of Thomas Mylet. Also  
four acres of meadow for allowance lying in the west end  
of a meadow in the north side of the town bounde.

Granted to Hugh Crispen ~~that~~ <sup>part</sup> ~~area~~ of meadow  
lying in the great river meadow on the west side of  
the river & lying to the meadow of Henry Curteis  
Also there a parcel of meadow containing by estimation  
two acres & a half or there abouts & the same more  
or less running Northward from the meadow of John  
Huddocks at parter to a little wood swamp at the north  
of it. Also a parcel of meadow containing by estimation  
one acre & the same more or less lying on both sides  
of the brook a little downward from the river parter going  
over the brook to Rudge meadow & called Exmeadow brook.

Granted to John Moore fifteen acres of upland lying upon  
the river parter next to the land of Thomas White & lying to  
of the land. W<sup>th</sup> John Moore formerly bought of John Stone  
Also three acres of meadow lying in the parter meadow  
between the meadow of William Forley & John Bent  
Also two acres of meadow lying in the south side of the  
town bounde in a parcel by itself.

Also seven acres of meadow lying on the west side  
between the meadow of Mr Edmund Verine & Henry Bent.

Also three acres of meadow lying on the north west brook  
between the meadow of Thomas White & Walter Hayes &  
ten acres is the allowance for a third division of meadow.
