shutles within this town shall this year not be
turned abroad without a licence of the lord's grace not
before any of the ground in any of the Great River
meadows from bridge point down wards towards the
the ground of this river to preserve the river meadows
for any default of the ground man suffering to be
paid to the town of the for any default of the
owner five pence a year. This order shall take effect
from day of May, until further order be taken.
