

It is ordered by the towne that John how shall be marshall for this present year
ensuing he is to receive with huge Criffen to take the moneys for any rates
that shall be in this present year & for the composing of the rate wch being
composed the said John how is to give men notice what they are to pay & gather
it for wch he is to have twenty shillings for his year's service

It is also ordered that huge Criffen shall attend the towne meetings to receive
towne orders & also to receive with the marshall in taking the moneys of all
rates for the year ensuing & also to compose the rate for wch he is to
have for his year's service twenty shillings

It is also ordered that after the marshall shall have given notice to men of the
same wch they are to pay for any rate & of the time of payment & the place
where they are to bring it any man shall be defaulting that the marshall be
constrained to go afterwards to gather it they that are defaulting shall pay the
marshall for his labor

It is ordered that John Went & John Wlandford shall have power to call out
men to the highway for this year being foundry for the same purpose

It is ordered that all ^{general} town's fields shall be inclosed wth a sufficient fence between
this and the 16th day of this present month & if any shall be defaulting so shall
forfeit for every rod of fence that is defaulting twelv pence, Thomas Kings to be
to the fence of that field where he dwells, John Moore & huge Criffen for the
field they lay in Robert Darrell & John printer senior for the field they lay in
John printer ^{junior} & Andrew Welger for the field they lay in John Buddards and
Henry Courtis for the field they lay in & William ward & John streetman
for their field
