The 5th day of the first month 1645 It is ordered that the town
shall pay for two bulls that shall be good bulls twenty shillings for a bull
yearly to be raised but upon the river and heifers that are two years old
and upwards equally for the south side of the river and the owners of such bulls
to be paid and those two bulls shall go free in the heard and also one
bull on the west side of the river and the owner of him to have all the twenty
shillings and the bull to go free in the heard provided that the owner of
those bulls shall not work ~~them~~ ^{them} the m^r Wendleton is appointed to
find a bull for the west side of the river for this year.

It is ordered that the rate levied for the plankings of the most myshouse and
other things this rate shall be paid into the marshalls between this and the
last day of this present month

It is ordered that all land that lyeth follow for the commons shall be freed from rates
for the year that such lands be followed
