his rate according to the apoyntment of the towne having lawful  
warning of his payment being once demanded. so hath also liberty  
to distraine for more as may pay his rate & also twelve pence  
for every default

Hugh Griffin is also apoynted to attend towne meetings for this  
year to write towne orders for w<sup>ch</sup> so is to send twenty shillings
