It is concluded by the town that William Wards shall enjoy the ^{ten acres} of meadows formerly granted him adjoining to the meadows of Walter Sayns ~~near to the old~~ in Rudyd Meadow.

John Budducke & Solomon Johnson said six acres of meadows say of them granted by the town.

The town also granted to Philomen whole ten acres of meadows granted to Richard Sanger six acres of meadow provided he do continue an inhabitant amongst us four years to do our ^{little} work.
