1697 It is ordered by the Senate that there
 shall be a new common land out on the west side of the River
 to amount to exactly with all the upland within the
 bounds that is to say all the upland that lies within the bounds
 that fall from bridge point through grass meadows off to
 the west at the meadow of Walter Hunt, & all the upland
 within the gulfe & the pasture back to the off end of the
 meadows of Robert Darnell & from thence to the westlynd
 as it shall be bounded by some men appointed by the Senate
 except it be some lands as are due to mee already &
 shall be laid out according to the lines appointed by the
 Senate Walter Hunt & John Court are appointed to bound the women
 from the meadows to the westlynd
