It is allso ordered that Edmond Thronow during ~~the time of his~~
to pay as formerly he did according to the promise of the town
formerly made unto him in the town of pastore rate.

It is allso agreed that the rate of eight pence myn shillings
levied upon mens estate for the payment of the town debt due at
the present & to buy a constables staffe to mende the stoke & to buy
a m^r m^r iron for the town & it shall be gathered by Hugh Griffyn
who is appointed by the town to receive rates to pay the town debt

May the 26th 1648. It is ordered in a publicke town meeting that there
shall be only two men chosen for one year from this day to oversee the making
& mending of all the higer wayes in the town

Walter Haynes & Robert Daruill are chosen for overseers for the higer way
as to their best direction shall seeme meete unto them to make m^r
according to the p^resent ord^r & they are to call out men to worke to
the full sume of two third p^{te} of the rate last levied for the pastore mainte-
nance for halfe a year according to such mans proportion.

Walter Haynes & Hugh Griffyn are appointed to goe down to the Court
now & maiestrate to confirme the bargain of land now bought
of Goodman & to take course for the payment of Goodman
& they shall be paid for their labour

Edmond Goodenow is desired to treat w^{ch} Leonard men that w^{ch}
some other that goe to remove & to agree w^{ch} them to about the
laying out the way betwixt Leonard & Sudbury
