It is agreed upon by the town that the fine pound w^{ch} is paid to
Godman shall be rayfed only by the meadowes as every man is
possest.

William Forbey Junior & Thomas Mayb are appointed to take an inquest
for the rate for the parson's maintenance for w^{ch} they are to have four
shillings a year. They are to rate all meadows at five shillings
an acre & but only what is laid out for third division & that is
to be rated at twelve pence an acre.

October 1st first 1648 It is agreed in a general towns meeting
that Walter Harms shall have two shillings for his going to
Boston & Hugh Griffin five shillings for his house & expenses
when they went to confirm the bargain wth goodman and he
paid to the recorder & they are to be paid in the next year it is to be
gathered for by payment of goodman.

It is also agreed that all meadows that are given by way of
gratulations shall have right in some name at the meadows w^{ch} are
first second & third divisions of meadows. & that for the raising
of the rate for payment of the last purchase of goodman at meadows
shall pay at one price

3 Hugard Smith is agreed why to carry our wobbly payment or go
it to pay a bill for his labor or it to take it up at full price
to settle it at our wobble.

36 for a pound their railed and to be wth 10 foot long e they are to
be ^{paid} for by railed at it is wth to be paid by next town rate
