betwene this and the last day of the first month
for the yformance whereof there shall be an order taken

The 13th day of the 12th month 1649 It is ordered by the town
& that in a publicke town meeting that Mr Nathl John printer
senior Robert Darnall & John Moor shall have power to speak
with Mr Hunt about her person house & estate & to take some
course for her release for present & future upon the town
charge & what they do in a prudentiall way the town
doe hereby promise to pay

Hugh Giffen & John Moor are appointed to take an inventory
of the powder bullets & money & for the pasted into the town
rate
