

- 1 At a town meeting the 4th day of January in the year 1652
ordered for the drawing of lots for the two miles granted
to Sudbury in the year 1649 the parcell of land commonly
called and known by the name of the new grant and also
the meeting ordered for to get the said new grant land
freely measured and divided according to former town acts
- 2 voted in the town meeting that there shall be a high way
thirty rods wide from south to north through the
said new grant beginning to the five miles first granted
the town of Sudbury
- 3 voted in the town meeting that there shall be a high way thirty
rods wide from south to north parallel with the other said
high way in the middell of the said remaining tract of land
- 4 voted in the town meetings that the high way to hereafter shall
be as it doth through the said divided tract of land, the said
high ways be stated the divided tract of land now layeth in four
long squares or squadrons
- 5 voted in the town meetings that the south east square or squadron
shall be and accounted to be the first the north east shall be
accounted the second, the north west square or squadron
shall be the third square or squadron the south west
square shall be and accounted the 4th and last squadron
- 6 voted in the town meetings that the first lot drawn shall begin
at the south side of our first squadron running east and west
betwixt our high ways the second lot to be in the north
side of the first and for every lot following successively
as they are drawn untill we come to our road line and
so that the first and second squadron be all divided
voted in the town and granted that Mr William Brownshall have
his farm and his great lot to gather in the north west angle
lying to our road bounds on the north the being the
first and north most part of the third squadron
the said lots are to lay successively from hence as they are drawn
untill the end of the fourth squadron in which we
reserve a tract of land for our open square with
one of the said lots
- 7 voted and agreed with Thomas noyes to survey this said
tract of land according to the our directions
- 8 voted in the town meetings that whereas there is a pond
lying in the third and fourth squadron that for our middell
high way from south to north cannot pass straight our will
and vote is that the said way shall goe round the pond
at the nearest end and that allowance be given by the
surveyor to any persons that shall be damaged by the
high way going at the ponds end
