these eleven lots above going with the sowyon land and the fourth and last Squadron the first where of being John moors who ioyning on the north to the fore sayd Lancaster Higge way the sowyon being the last which ioyning on the south to the wilderness these sayd eleven lots and sowyon butinge on the east the fore sayd middell Higge way and first Squadron and butting on the west the wilderness

Also let it be remembered that the long Higge way from fourth to north goes at the west end of the road through the lands of John Toll and Solomon Gonson and is 12 rods wide at the new row of the fore which way they the sayd John Toll and Gonson are situated all on
