County of Middlesex planter have given granted bargained & sold & by
these p^{re}sents give grant bargain & sell unto Thomas Gyllynton of
Sudbury in the same towne & County planter a y^ell of meadows
containing by estimation ten acres or there abouts & y^e said more or lesse
lying in a meadow commonly called by the name of the pasture meadow
w^{ch} is the whole of my third division of meadows & lyeth between the meadows
of John Buddock on the one side & John Moor on the other side And all
the right in & reversion belonging to saide acres of it reserving all the
right in & reversion to the other that acres of meadows to myselfe all
w^{ch} ten acres of meadows & reversion to saide acres I have sold to the
said Thomas Gyllynton, to have & to hold unto the said Thomas Gyllynton
his heirs & assigns Administrators & assigns from the day of the date hereof
for ever, In witness whereof I have hereunto sett my hand the fourth
day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred forty eight
