

February 22nd 1664

Layd out unto John Smith four acres and one halfe of upland on the west side of Sudbury river joining the east side to four acres of land formerly layd out to John Smith having a zigzag way leading to Langman on the east and a zigzag way leading from the Town of Sudbury to the river mill on the north and his own meadow being on the south. Yet it is remembered that there is about one acre and halfe of land belonging to the Town of Sudbury lying between the town acres of upland and the four acres of meadow of the said John Smith at the west end of his said four acres and one halfe was layd out to him by the said John Smith in lieu of four acres and one halfe of upland he layd down on the green place on the east side of Sudbury river above the lands of Thomas White.

29th of April 1665

Layd out unto Jonathan Sturges the day and year above written four acres of upland on the east side of the great Common swampy near the north end of Sudbury bounds lying and being northward to some lands formerly layd out to John Freeman the four said four acres of land being bounded on the west by the Common swampy and also bounded on the east by a tract way joining under the hill as the trees are now marked, four acres of the said four acres was in lieu of four acres of the said John Sturges layd down to the Town of Sudbury also on the green place above the lands of Thomas White the other four acres was given him by the Town of Sudbury upon the instigation of Mr. pastor M^r Brown.

May 29 1665

Layd out unto Phillipon Whall the day and year above written four acres of upland on the green place joining on the west to the land of the middle garden and on the east to the four acres of land being formerly layd down above the lands of Thomas White also bounded on the south by the zigzag way leading to water town his said four acres of land was layd out unto the said Phillipon Whall in lieu of four acres of upland of the said Phillipon Whall layd down to the Town of Sudbury also on the green place above the lands of Thomas White.

June 23 1665

Layd out unto Henry Curtis the day and year above written 9 acres of upland on the east side of Sudbury river northerly easterly unto the lands formerly layd out unto Hugh Corry and southerly unto the meadow of upland was part of the four acres of upland to the said Henry Curtis bought of Thomas White of Sudbury the four acres of the said four acres formerly of John Knight of Sudbury the other four acres of the said four acres being formerly layd out Henry Curtis at his meadow at Castle Hills being an instant in the said meadow.
