20th Day of June - 1663
Layd out unto Thomas Moyes by witnessant Goodnow and Henry, two
the day and year above written fifteen acres of land at the new mill
in Sudbury formerly of it being bounded on the east by eight acres of
land which was primitively granted unto (King and now ten but sold and
to Thomas and poster moyes also the said fifteen acres is bounded on the
north by the great cart way leading from the Town of Sudbury
unto the fore said new mill also bounded on the south partly by the eight way
and pastures meadow and the meadow of goodwife whalley (being a part of the
mill brooke at the east end of the line and taking in the mill and
the dams and part of the ponds being bounded at the north west
angle by a great wet oak and at the south west angle by a small
piece a little to the southward of the pond, the other two acres
being part of the said fifteen and is bounded on the south by the cart
way leading from the millers house over the fore said brooke and
also bounded on the east by the way which leadeth from the brooke
unto the house of Josiah Gains a great piece being the north east
corner and from thence along running with the fence or six rods
of the meadow called egg meadow bearing away round the
land for the passage out of the meadow according to former
town order, the above said fifteen acres of land was granted
unto Thomas moyes and his heirs for ever in lieu of fifteen
acres of land layd down by his dwelling for the accommodation
of a good way into the woods to the pauntery meadows

Also layd out unto witnessant Edmund Goodnow 40 acres of upland
joining to the west meadow formerly granted to Mr Robert
Hordom by the Towne of Sudbury, & now is in the possession of
the said Edm Goodnow with said 40 acres of upland to the same
more or less as followeth: vizt: beginning at the stake between
the meadow granted to John Maynor & the meadow granted to
Mr Robert Hordom & running upon the north point 40 rods
way that goeth from the north point untill it comes to the Cart
then bearing that Cart way to the gravel pits to the new mill
to the Cart way, vizt: goeth to the north west & it runs
Cart way on the west & so to the north to the whit oake of
Hordom & the meadow granted to Mr Hunt all which lands
the said Edm Goodnow bought of sundrell persons as in their
deeds doe more fully appear.
