all a long by the side of Mr Joseph Noyes Meadow y^t was
formerly laid out to Robt Dardill & a gainst y^e of the
Meadow of Sir John Rudock & y^e of the Meadow formerly
granted to Hugh Griffins & soe for as it runs a gainst y^e
Meadow of Sir John Rudock & Hugh Griffins there is a high
way markt out, the other Acres of Land of y^e a boue &
twenty two Acres & a half, laid out on an Island of upland

granted to Robt Dardill one the north end of shew by Meadow
with fower chert of Meadow is also laid out & markt wth
a great whit oak on y^e south, westerly & a mayler on

Specified is in Consideration of fower Acres & a half of Land
turning to y^e Land of Sir John Rudock called north Haye &
y^e Land formerly granted unto Geo Knight & himselfe Acres
of y^e 3d Mr Noyes sighted Acres lying neare west
Meadow & also in consideration of six Acres granted
by the Towne of Sudbury to Elias Rogers provided y^e
3d Elias performe his engadgment to y^e Towne if
not y^e 3d Mr Noyes to Volingwish his wholl sighted Acres
neare west Meadow wth a boue & fower Acres & a half
& himselfe Acres to gather wth y^e six Acres granted to
Elias Rogers are all Volingwished & laid downe by y^e
