At a town meeting the day and year above written awarded
for the choice of men to run and lay out a Country
road between Marlborough and Sudbury. For that John Grant
for that John Sparrow and Thomas Noyes are chosen
a committee to lay out with Marlborough men laying out
a Country road between Marlborough and Sudbury.

At a town meeting the 6 of June 1664 granted unto Mary
Tibbs the day and year above written thirty rods of land near his house
at Latham so it more or less as now it is bounded and fenced by the last
of the said John Grant and Thomas Noyes on the east and south east
side of his house. Also at a town meeting the day and year above written
for a small period and issue of all disputes between John Coll of Sudbury
about the bounding of his land on the north side of his house on the
one side granted and confirmed by the town of Sudbury on the south east side of his house
said fence is set out most into the said way the said fence
shall be measured in round one way the length of twelve foot at the extremity
angle of the house of the same and from the end of fence of the
said John Coll upon a line unto the corner of the house of the same
fence by somewhat less his fence to be done by John Coll within
two years next after the date here of also granted unto John Coll
to remove his fence at the north east end of the said land on the same
the one way the length of twelve foot more to the north east all the
way the breadth of his land; from his old dwelling in his house
his water and several other manifested discontent.

At a town meeting the 16 of May 1664 granted liberty unto
Thomas Stowers to lay down the six acres of land which was
laid out to him in the middle of the same place near unto
John Cutlers place the same was by the way of the said
from the town unto the house of John Cutler also granted
liberty unto the said Thomas Stowers to take up the said six acres
of land on the north west side of the land of John Cutler and also
on the north side of the land which the said Thomas Stowers
purposed of John Cutlers and also on the north side of the land of
John Cutler the said lands not prejudicing the said way.
also granted to the said Thomas Stowers his shop stand on and the
land which is joined in by his shop in line of the town
was first granted to the said Thomas Stowers for the building
of his shop.
