Goodnow m^r Joseph Noyes m^r Blewens and appointed firwayers of the field fence
where they dwell from by lane at John mainors to by lane at fergout
farmers

Also Henry Loker and William moors are appointed firwayers for by
ground over the fields where Henry Loker dwelleth and by field fence
where Solomon Toulson dwelleth and also for by field fence of by
field wing was John Fidiats and also of by fields of fergout wood
and John wooder

Also fergout Josiah Hains and Edward worst are appointed firwayers
of all by field fence on the west side of Sudbury great River as
also of lanham fields north and by fields at and by by new
mill except only m^r Herbert golthams farm

Also John Stout senior and Corporall Henry Crow are appointed
firwayers of all by field fence where they now dwell and also
of all by field fence on by east side of Sudbury river being on
by fount by side of quins brooke

Also Phillipon Sergeant Crowt and Jonathan Stanage are appointed
firwayers of by fields where fergout Crowt and Jonathan Stanage
dwelleth and also of by fields fence between millbrook and
quins brooke and of by field fence where some time in by
lands of John woods eastward upon by hill till now in
by town and occupation of Peter Noyes John Ollin
and Jonathan Stanage

Also Peter Noyes and m^r William Brown are appointed firwayers
of by field fence where they dwell

Also John Blanford and Peter Ringe are appointed firwayers of
by fields where they now dwell and also of by field fence
on by west side of by lane leading to the common swamp
and also of all by field fence upon by hill from by little pond
by by now dwelling goes of John Blanford unto millbrook
and also of by field fence of Phillipon whole where he now
dwelleth

And also for the generall firwayers of all by field fence in this our Town
and bounds of Sudbury in and about by ending of all disputes arising
about by sufficiently of fence. we have chosen constituted and appointed
our trusty friends m^r Joseph Noyes fergout John Crowt and Corporall
John Rutter to arise issue and determine all matters of disputes
arising about by sufficiently of fence ordering them by sayd byes
firwayers to receive the sum of twelve pence each on an every
time they by sayd firwayers are employed and by sayd twelve pence
appeare to be payd at all times and times to every one of them
before they enter upon by worke of furway by person or persons
to pay by by sayd twelve pence is and shall be given
magistrates or magistrates and in case by sayd firwayers receive not
the by twelve pence as above sayd it shall not be accounted lawful
for them to receive any fence or fence
