It is orde^d at y^e affores^d meeting of y^e 11th March³⁰
yt Joseph Grants have Imbde of the Comon of the
Towne to build him a Dwelling house on y^e of
y^e Land formerly giuen him to erect a smithes shop
on y^e whichd yt y^e said Grants shall not at any time
grue lett out mortgage sell or any way elc make
oude y^e said house y^e said house to any but to a
Towns man or ffeeshold^r of this Towne or such person
or persons as the sd Towns men shall approve of &
in Case of non agreement yt might hapen by
reason hereof when he shall at any time putt this
sd house & Land to sale two men shall be Chosen
only by this Towne the one by the said Grants who
shall put a full & small Determination & sd thereto
& in the mean time the said Joseph Grants his heirs
& furrors shall not by vertue of the afores^d Grant
of Timber & Liberty to Build his sd house enjoye any
other priuiledge elther on y^e Comon for feed^r or
wood, Timber &c of this Towne or the bound^r h^{er}es
elther y^e pines for^{the} forge w^{ch} he shall putt
only in such places in & about this Towne
as Mr Joseph Noyes & w^m Moores (or such other
as this Towne shall at any time here after
orde^d to giue liensure or direction to him therein)
shall from time to time appoint
& upon those Conditions y^e said Joseph Grants Did
except of the afores^d Grant of Timber to build

It is orde^d yt Mrs Hunt of this Towne widow shall haue
fifty shillings pention allowed & paid her out of y^e
next Towne rate.
