to Towne Rates

Orderd y^e no fernes cattle sh^{all} be removed by any person in this
Towne shall not be taken into y^e Inboyr; but if any
such cattle be kept by any on mounth after y^e hoard
goeth out to Green shall be liable to pay for other cattle
This orde to stand till y^e Towne forsaith to alter it
