portion y^e her out of y^e next Towne Rate

orde y^t Jonathⁿ Stangor shall receive y^e meeting house y^e year
ensuing & have Twenty li^s shillings for y^e year

orde y^t a committee of five inhabitants be chosen who shall
be empowered to keep y^e Towne Booke seriously & to take
notice in writing of all such Grants & Rewards of
Lands w^{ch} may occasion future trouble & y^t they give
notice of y^e same & place where they meet
upon y^t a faide y^t see these inhabitants concerned may
if they please be present & y^t taking in writing w^{ch}
is necessary to present unto y^e Towne to present y^e
same upon a publick Towne meeting y^t if it may
be wth best consent, trouble & contention may
be prevented

to discuss some portion tract of upland & Meadow to
be sold for the procuring of a futable flight of
Colours for the use of the military Company

orde y^t y^e mill lands be recorded in the Towne Booke
as it is stated & laid out by the Towne for bay
for the laying out of the Towne Land

orde y^t what so ever debts are due to y^e Towne or two
y^e months y^t y^e select men doe take an effectuall course
for the procuring of y^e
