house a third pt to be abated to chm if will pay bulleth
4^d pt to be money y^t is of their proportions to y^e said rate
this rate to be paid to Sonat^y Stanhepp for y^e w^{ch}
of y^e Towne as afore said y^e being appointed by y^e
select men to gather in y^e said rate
