At a meeting of the Eldermen of this Town the

It is orde y^t a rate of seven pounds six shillings & eight pence for
the County be made upon the Inhabitants of this Town (by the rate of y^e
last Inquest to the Minister) & that the Constables of this Town doe
collect the said sum according to ord^r & pay the same to y^e County Treasurer.

All fowes are to be m^d
sufficiently by the 20th
April

It is also orde that all the fowes of the Count^y Particular Dorset fowles within
this Town & bounds hereof be well & sufficiently m^d & finished at
or before the 20th of this instant April, in all respects as was orde the 12th
of marche 1666 (see this booke folio 46) upon forfeiture y^t the owners shall
pay or cause to be paid unto y^e respective Surveyors of fowes & woods
named & appointed to that field & wood for every Rod y^t shall aff^r y^e
expiration of the said time be found defective, over & above all damages that
shall arise by y^e insufficiency of sure fowes, & all fowes are to be also
sufficiently maintained in this manner. Except up till the end of Indian Eares
the Surveyors in their severall divisions are as follow^e viz

Mr. Joseph Noyes & John Rutter are appointed to be Surveyors of the field
fowes weedy & dwell from the land at the foregoing Maynards to the
land at the widow Parvulens
Henry Leaker & Jacob Moore are appointed Surveyors of the field fowes weedy
Henry Leaker dwells & Henry Swilsh fields, & y^e fields of In. Bruden, George
Hedman, & John Rutter, Rodina: Gambelaine & Daniel, Marshes & aff^r
John: Jones Hains, Geo: Road, & Edward Wrigel are appointed Surveyors of
all the field fowes on the west side of the Great River of this Town &
Landham & Probertott, y^e new mill or Mr. Polzams Harrow only excepted.
Matthieu Rite & Joseph Gleding are appointed Surveyors of all the field
fowes weedy & dwell, & of all the field fowes on the east side of the
Great River of this Town being on the east side of Pine brooke.
Philomen Whale, Eusebius John Grant & Jonathan Gleding are appointed Surveyors
of y^e field fowes weedy & dwell persons dwell Call etc. field fowes between
the Mill brooke & Pine brooke & of the field fowes of y^e w^e formerly was John
Hoods Eastward upon y^e hill, & Henry Swilsh's new fields & the field of Geo:
Rite & Mr. Polz Noyes & Geo:
Mr. Polz Noyes, & In. Allen are appointed Surveyors of the field fowes weedy
the w^e Noyes & Geo: Brown dwell.
John Blanford & Peter King are appointed Surveyors of y^e field fowes weedy
the dwell, & of the field fowes on the west side of the land leading to Common & w^e
& on the hill from y^e little Pond to Mill brooke, & of the field fowes of Philomen
weedy & dwell.

Count Surveyors

Moreover Eusebius John Grant, Mr. Joseph Noyes & Eusebius John Rutter are
renewed & appointed to be Count Surveyors of all the field fowes within this
Town & the bounds hereof weedy & empowered to hear & determine all matters
& differences arising about the sufficiency & insufficiency of all fowes weedy
and to demand & receive the due sum of money as directed it at any time weedy
till the before the god upon the words.

Every house is to have
A sufficient ladder

It is orde that every household within this Town & y^e limits hereof, have
& be always provided with a good strong & sufficient ladder at his dwelling
equal & of sufficient length to reach up to the top of his house for the removal
of fire & that may happen, on penalty of paying the sum of shillings for want hereof
& John Allen is appointed to be the expiration of this ord^r on the east side of the
Great River of this Town & Edward Wrigel on the west of the Great River, weedy &
to receive & deliver the fine & fines upon any's neglect of this ord^r.
