Edward Givon granted bargain & sold & transferred (by the Town of Sudbury & the
Proprietors thereof) unto Thomas & Thomas of the Town, to his heirs & assigns
Dominion & Assignments forever. All that parcel & parcel of common meadow ground
it is situated lying & being in Lind meadow [between two parcels of meadow
belonging to the said Thomas & Thomas (one of them was formerly given to him by the
Town & the other was formerly bought of John Woods) & so as the said
now the said joined altogether in one parcel of meadow with his two
former parcels above.] with all manors of Ridges & privileges whatsoever
thereunto belonging. And this is for & in consideration of a barrel of Gunpowder
the said Thomas & Thomas gave, bought, brought up & delivered to the Town, for a Town stock
with fifty eight shillings, & also remaining in his lands of the money to
common swamps was sold for to Thomas & Thomas & John Parmenter in March
1670, & also given & granted to the said Thomas & Thomas is a full due and
satisfaction from him the said Thomas & Thomas, for the said common meadow above
granted, & made over to him; to his heirs & assigns, & Assignments forever.
