It is ordered that onunday y<sup>e</sup> 31<sup>st</sup> of March next, there shall be a goodly meeting  
of the Inhabitants of this Town at the meeting house at midday before noon  
to order the Invoites of the valuable estates (to be taken in y<sup>r</sup> manner) to be  
taken & to be in the meeting house, & to order & determine the Town debts  
& to order the common meadows, & for dispatch of such other business  
as shall be presented.

Minister's Rate

It is ordered that the said year's rate of forty pounds due to the minister ending y<sup>e</sup>  
last day of February last be forthwith made by the Invoites last taken of the estates  
of the Inhabitants of this Town now presented & was before the Town, & that the said  
shall be added & added to fifty shillings more for the said year's firewood due to y<sup>e</sup> day  
arriving to agreement 20<sup>th</sup> of March 1679. on folio 100. & that the said Rate when made  
be forthwith to be made & then made to the minister's hand.

ord<sup>d</sup> that the Town rate of  
to be made by the Inhabitants of this Town by the Constables for the payment of  
y<sup>e</sup> Town debts

It is ordered  
for wolf killing

It is ordered that the Law appointing every Town to pay ten shillings for every wolf  
if it killed by any person within the limits of their Town this Town shall pay to  
any person that shall kill a wolf within the limits of this Town & bring the dead body  
of the wolf to the Constables ten shillings more. And all former ord<sup>s</sup> & relating to any  
allowance for killing wolves made by this Town is & shall be hereby repealed.  
And all persons that pay rates to this Town shall pay any wolf upon their own lands  
except not within the limits shall save the said rate of ten shillings.
