ordered & voted that the agreement made at a Town meeting with m^r Sam^l Sturges
Esq^rman minister concluded the 30th of December 1678 as it stands entered
in the books of the Town on folio 100. shall be fairly drawn
into forme in two papers or draughts, and for the sd m^r Sturges to sign
the same for the Towns use, & the other to be signed & sealed by Captⁿ Edm^d Goodenow
Lieut^{nt} Josias Staines, Ensign John Groat, & m^r Peter Noyes or any three
of them in behalfs of the Town for the sd m^r Sam^l Sturges use,
his vote was passed by the Town at m^r Sturges desired & demand.

ordered that the old pond of this Town we are it now stands be forthwith
repaired at the Town charge by John Browne, Edw^d Rutter, John Groat
m^r Peter Noyes, Ensign John Groat, Corp^t Jonathan Stangor, Edw^d Staines, m^r Edw^d
Browne, Robert Man, Peter King. & y^e the Loggs about the meeting house be
made use of by them for that end, & y^e m^r Joseph Noyes at the work the same
be drawn the Loggs to the Pond: & the persons above named and others so to
maintain it at the sd Pond be sufficiently repaired & finished before
the next County Court to be held at Cambridge in April next & for that end
not to differ to begin at longer than the second Monday of the April
the charge of the work to be paid out of the next Town rate shortly to
be made.
ordered with consent of Sam^l Sturges that the sd build a new pair of stairs
at the meeting house of this Town, & the sd Sam^l Sturges
shall promise to finish the same substantially & well before the next
County Court to be held in April next & for the same so to be paid out
of the next Town rate shortly to be made.
