At a full meeting of the inhabitants of this Towne March 14th 1680,

The Last Indoyne taken of y^e Ratable estates of y^e inhabitants of this Towne
was then publicly read before them & it was read & ordered y^e Senate of Boston
Jonath Griffin Jun^r Gleaming for: then y^e y^e widow Bent was cancelled one
the Indoyne & be Left out of y^e Rates ordered to be made by y^e y^e y^e

ordered y^e m^r James Shermans last half years Rate shall be forthwith
made & bet him
ordered y^e y^e Towns Rate be forthwith made by y^e said Indoyne & bet
to y^e Constables to pay y^e Towns Debts

Whereas y^e inhabitants of this Towne at their meetings formerly
first on y^e 25th Feb^r 1677 folio 97 & 6th of May 1678 folio 98
did constitute Capt Edm Goodnow Deor Mr. Heynes m^r Joseph Noyes
& m^r Jn^r Greene as a Committee in their behalf to see some
& settle all strumps between m^r Edm Brown late yester of the
inhabitants of this Towne & to ease all y^e remains due to him
to be paid in & to see y^e Towne discharged: the said Committee
having finished that matter gave y^e Towne at this meeting
a full strump thereof to y^e Townes satisfaction w^{ch} they have
now expressed their great full acceptance of their services
for y^e Towne therein & as a further manifestation thereof the
Towne voted & ordered that y^e said Committee should have
fifty pounds for their paynes collected of y^e inhabitants
by y^e present Towne Rate ordered to be made & upon y^e motion
of m^r Jn^r Greene of y^e above named Committee y^e Towne ordered that y^e
three first of y^e above named Committee to have 20th apiece
thereof & y^e remaining 40th to y^e four named m^r Jn^r Greene:

Upon y^e Request of m^r Jn^r Greene made to y^e Towne at this
meeting it is voted concluded & ordered y^e to agree with that
John of Land be fore his Dwelling house within this Towne
y^e Ramoth duen with y^e old fences w^{ch} were pertained to the
first Grant of that Land upon his house standeth hee
shall have Liberty & power to run his fence southward into
y^e Towne Street y^e whole Length of y^e house & as much
further as shall with y^e with was his own be fore make
his yeard & Garding plots there all a Long be fore his
yeard sixeens fute wide from y^e dore & from the
to outmost corner posts of y^e said house w^{ch} is given
& Granted to him by y^e Towne to be his & his heirs
& Assignes for ever

ordered y^e Jn^r For more pay only 12th in money w^{ch} y^e Towne
except as full satisfaction for y^e Comon meadow hee given
last year

ordered y^e y^e Common meadows of this Towne shall not be Left out
for the year ensuing
