dilect & prouge want or defect therof during the said term (wch term shal be from
the day of the said order) for in consideration wherof the said Peter King
is to have all the logs left of the fortification about the mooring & erect-
ing the water & the said posts & Planks that were & are about the
gate of the said fortification the said town & so to it self his agreement was
made the 14 of march 1689. witness Peter King
