At A meeting of the Justices of the Peace for the County of Wilts. 18th April 1682

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It is ordered that the Town Clerk do write all & send draw out a rate contain-
ing out money of the Towns proportion to a single County rate (according
to the last found labour of the persons & estates valuated in the County)
to be paid in money for the next year & a half of the County Agents appointed to
be sent for England amount to about nine pounds four shillings eight
pence for the Constables & by speedily to collect the same of the Inhabitants
in & about the Town & to be paid in according to the Exchequer warrant
dated the 21st of March last past for the said. [see the said below]
It is ordered that the Constables of the Town do demand & receive the Town
weights in the & above said & by the way send down to the Exchequer
of the County or the City & send them down now sit at the stamp according
to law made the 15th of February last & give all the town's weight to return
down to the Exchequer again.
It is ordered that the Justices of the Peace made the 13th of March last &
as the said now drawn & returned in the Town book on folio 110, be and
deliberately read & published soon after the next let the said to be on the
26th of the present month (April) to the Inhabitants of the Town for all to take
notice of & observe. [Indorsed: this was done according to the said folio 110.]
It is ordered that after the publication by reading the said last aforesaid
the Town Clerk do as soon as may be issue out warrants to the persons
particularly appointed to see the said & order to observe that they carefully
attend their respective duties every way & by day & night.
