According to an ord^r of his Court dated 20th of March 1603⁴ Impowering Daron In^r Hounds
to measure & lay out of meadow by some called the Kings meadow lying in the
meadow adjoining to Polton Kings farm Acres of meadow being 500 less book folio 116.
The said Daron Hounds made his return 20th of 1st folio: vizt on 20th of 1st of 1604
I began to measure the said on the side next Pol^r Kings meadow & ran the first
line from the upland on the south side of the said down to the river where the
fourth road; the second line I ran from the end along by the river as near as the road
nearly the third line from the end on the north side of the said part of meadow
I ran the line from the river up to the upland fifth road; the fourth line from the end
from the end on the east side by the upland till we came to the road and began
fifth four roads: the whole part contained 600000 Acres more or less.
